Dear Ansab Ali,

We inform you that your application for admission to the master's degree program in Mechanical Engineering for Sustainability was successful.

To apply for enrollment in the 2026/27 academic year, usually beginning from mid-July, you will have to:

- prepare the following documents:

1. bachelor's degree, legalized or apostilled, along with the **dichiarazione di valore in loco**, issued by the Italian embassy or consulate in the Country where the degree was awarded; alternatively, you can apply for both the certificate of **comparability** and the certificate of **authenticity** on the dedicated CIMEA [webpage](#)
Please note: the certificates referring to the comparability of qualifications relating to the 55 countries of the Lisbon Convention can be downloaded directly and free of charge through [Automatic Recognition Database Italia – ARDI](#).
For these qualifications, only the certificate of verification of the authenticity – to be requested via CIMEA – will be required.
2. transcript of academic records, legalized or apostilled.

Please note that as far as we are concerned, documents issued in English, French or Spanish do not need to be translated in Italian. However, an official translation in Italian may be required by the Italian embassy/consulate.

- **(Only if you are a non-EU citizen living abroad)** Besides the above listed documents, you have to:
 - apply for pre-enrollment and visa request via [University – International Students](#). [The portal will open approximately in March 2026 for the 2026/27 a.y. pre-enrollment procedure]
Deadline for the pre-enrollment to unrestricted access degree programs at the University of Florence: **31 July 2026**
 - pass the Italian language test annually organized by the University, unless you have a valid certificate of Italian language proficiency at level B2 (**Only if the master program is in Italian**).

N.B.: **Chinese applicants of the Marco Polo programme**, who are already in Italy with a valid student residence permit, do not need to apply for pre-enrollment for the 2026/27 academic year via University. They are required to have a valid certificate of Italian proficiency at level B1 (only if the master program is in Italian).

Finally, we would like to remind you that the admission to the master program and the validation of the pre-enrollment application on University by the University do not grant:

- Any right to obtain the entry visa, since all visa formalities fall under the **exclusive jurisdiction** of the Italian diplomatic missions abroad
- Any right to be enrolled in the master program. Enrollment is subject to:
 - the verification by the University of the validity and authenticity of the entry qualification through the dichiarazione di valore or CIMEA certificates of comparability and verification
 - the master's degree program being included in the University educational offering for the 2026/27 a.y.
